THE UNIVERSITY OF NOTTINGHAM

The University of Nottingham, whose roots go back to 1877 as the University College Nottingham, is one of the UK's most popular universities.

The University has a thriving community of over 30,000 students, of which more than 5,500 come from outside the UK.

The closest airport to the University is Nottingham East Midlands airport, however, this airport only has direct flights from European destinations.

It is possible to travel directly to Nottingham from both Heathrow and Gatwick airports, both in London.

LOCATION AND CAMPUSES

The University of Nottingham is a multi-campus university.

The University Park campus is one of the largest and most attractive campuses in the UK. Set in extensive woodland, parks and playing fields, it is just three miles from the city centre.

The Jubilee Campus, opened by Her Majesty The Queen in December 1999, is only one mile from University Park and houses the Schools of Education, Computer Science and Information Technology, and the Business School.

The Sutton Bonington Campus, located in a rural setting, ten miles to the south of the city, is home to the School of Biosciences and has its own teaching buildings, hall of residence and sports facilities. There is a free shuttle-bus service between the three campuses.
