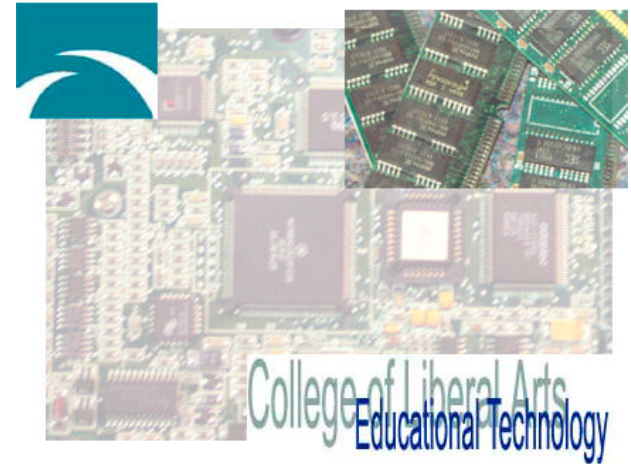
The site is an annotated “best of the best” guide to educational technology and instructional methods web sites that is organized from basic to advanced topics
