READMISSION POLICY FOR THE COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS

Any student who was not enrolled at Texas A&M University for the previous semester (excluding summer sessions) must apply for readmission through the Office of Admissions and Records. Application deadlines for readmission are:

Fall semester	August 1
Spring semester	November 15
Summer (both terms)	May 1

NOTE: The College of Liberal Arts **will not** request a waiver of the application deadline. In most cases, course work in progress at the time of application will not be considered in determining readmission eligibility.

STUDENTS WHO LEFT IN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING

- A. Liberal Arts students who are eligible for readmission will be allowed to return to their most recent major in the College of Liberal Arts **if they have not been blocked (dismissed) from that major.**
- B. Students who:
- wish to be readmitted into a Liberal Arts major
 - are blocked from their current majors
 - wish to change majors within the College of Liberal Arts
- must meet the requirements for their desired major within the College of Liberal Arts. See the College of Liberal Arts Change of Curriculum Policy (See “How to Change your Major” handout available at “Changing into Liberal Arts” under “Procedures” at <http://cla.tamu.edu/uss>).

STUDENTS WHO DID NOT LEAVE IN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING

- A. Students who have less than a 2.0 GPR and who were **not last enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts** are not eligible for admission to the College of Liberal Arts.
- B. Students who have less than a 2.0 GPR, who were last enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts, and who were **on probation by the College of Liberal Arts** when they last attended Texas A&M, may apply for readmission through the Office of Admissions and Records.
- C. Students who were **dismissed from the College of Liberal Arts** are not eligible for readmission to the College of Liberal Arts.
- D. **Please note:**
Students who have completed **fewer than 60 hours** and were **dismissed** for scholastic deficiency **may meet qualifications to apply for readmission through General Academics.** Please consult with an advisor in General Academics for information on their readmission requirements (104 Academic Building, 845-5916).
- E. Readmission **is not guaranteed.** Each application is evaluated on its own merits.
