The College of Liberal Arts Endowed Scholarships

In the fall, students in the College of Liberal Arts who have achieved a 3.75 GPR in at least 12 hours of course work in their first semester at Texas A&M University are sent an application for these scholarships. Recipients are selected by a faculty committee. Students who have been awarded an endowed scholarship retain them until graduation (a maximum of three years) as long as they are majoring in a subject in Liberal Arts and maintain a GPR of 3.5 or better while completing at least 12 hours a semester.

The scholarships are normally valued at \$1,000 per year, unless endowment earnings make it advisable to set a different amount. Students who hold a President's Endowed, Lechner, McFadden, or other substantial scholarships are not eligible.

Departmental Scholarships

Economics

Neal Hahn Memorial scholarship

Mr. and Mrs. Walter Hahn of Fort Worth, Texas have endowed the scholarship in memory of one of the department's former honors students, Neal Hahn. Students who will be a senior Economics major next fall with a GPR of 3.00 or better are urged to apply.

Jacqueline M. Browning Memorial Scholarship

The Jacqueline M. Browning Memorial Scholarship Program was endowed by her many friends (both students and faculty). Professor Jacqueline M. Browning was a distinguished author, an outstanding teacher, and a caring counselor to the faculty and students of the Texas A&M Department of Economics. Students who will be a senior Economics major next fall with a GPR of 3.5 or better and who will have taken four Economics courses by the end of the spring are urged to apply.

English

The Stewart and Anna Morgan Scholarship

The Stewart and Anna Morgan Scholarship is awarded each year to a student in English on the basis of his/her academic record. Both entering freshmen and current students are eligible to apply. Awards range in amounts up to \$1,500 per year. Renewal of the scholarship is possible but not automatic.

The Carroll Laverty Memorial Scholarship in English

The Carroll Laverty Memorial Scholarship is awarded each year to one junior or senior English major on the basis of academic record and need. The amount of the scholarship depends on the availability of funds; usually between \$1,500 and \$2,000 is awarded per year.

Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program

The Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program (UROP) provides English students the opportunity to (1) pursue an independent, focused research project for academic credit; (2) work with a faculty member on his/her own research in a mentoring relationship; (3) earn money. Appointments to this program are for one semester and pay \$500. Typically, three UROP appointments are awarded each semester.

Journalism

The Audrey Cardenas Memorial Scholarship

The Audrey Cardenas Memorial Scholarship provides financial assistance to outstanding Journalism students. Eligible students must have maintained a minimum GPR of 2.0 as of the semester prior to applying and they must demonstrate financial need.

Endowed Scholarships

The Department of Journalism also offers the following endowed scholarships, available on a competitive basis to majors already enrolled in the Journalism program:

One or more awards ranging from \$250 to \$1,200 are made from each of these funds depending on the amount of the annual income available.

Sociology

Nelson-Skrabaneck and Dan Russell Endowments

The Sociology faculty has a Student Awards Committee responsible for administering the Nelson-Skrabaneck and Dan Russell Endowments. The committee considers the competitive application of honors-eligible Sociology majors for these awards and determines the amount of funding given. Theater Arts

C. K. Estin Scholarship

The C. K. Estin Scholarship is awarded through the Former Students Association. Juniors or seniors in Theater Arts who maintain one of the top five GPRs in the Theater Arts program are eligible.
